Coffee, Tea, Conversation, Inspiration...

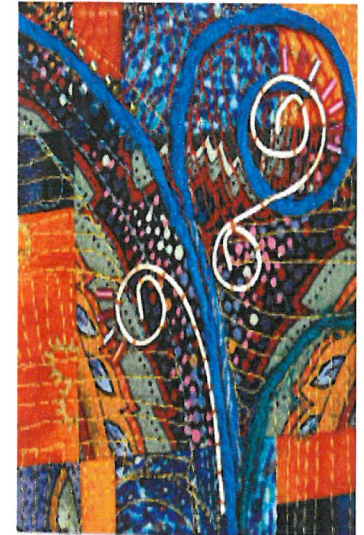
