  - a. Amy Broome – MSB Emergency Management – Spoke about the Borough addressing project. Flyer attached.
  - b. Ken Barkley – MSB Emergency Services Deputy Director – Fire – Water tank project (33,000 gal.) at Sutton Fire Dept. will be completed in approx. 3 weeks. Approach/circle was improved to handle 40' fire apparatus. Outdoor lighting and tank level lights are being installed. Currently waiting for pump to arrive. Sutton Fire will be receiving a Yamaha side-by-side outfitted with a slide in skid unit for transporting patients. Hydraulic tools are being updated to battery operated units. Head lamps, helmet lights and road flares are being replaced.

  - d. Jim Sykes – Borough Assembly, District 1 – Reported on Glenn Highway projects MP 42-61 and 66-90. An additional \$40,000 was added to the Alpine RSA 31 budget to cover repair of project on 58 Mile Road and general summer maintenance of roads. Jim has inserted \$100,000 for planning for the Slipper Lake/Jonesville plan in the Parks and Rec. Bond Package. Spoke with Trooper Degraf about ongoing investigation of the death at the Jonesville/Slipper Lake area. There will be no additional patrols to the area until funds are available to add patrols.
