Mark,

In case local folks are unaware, Copper Valley Electric Association (CVEA) and others are actively promoting a high voltage transmission line (an "intertie" project) estimated to cost \$525 million. A high voltage transmission line would necessarily be routed through Sutton, Chickaloon and Glacier View. It would roughly parallel the Glenn Highway north of the highway... probably along the route identified 25 years ago.

As you likely recall, about 25 years ago CVEA aggressively pushed for a similar but smaller project called "The Sutton-Glennallen Intertie". That project failed due to inadequate funding and strong opposition by many entities, including the Chickaloon and Sutton community councils.
